Perfect for Georgian windows, glazed doors and other multi-pane glazing, Liquid Mask removes the need to individually tape every pane of glass. Once the painting is complete, the coating peels away by hand in one piece, leaving the glass clean, clear and residue-free.

Once the paint has cured, peel away the coating by hand to reveal perfectly clean glass and sprayed frames.
